## Overseed Mixture

Overseed Mix is a combination of improved Kentucky bluegrasses and fine-textured perennial ryegrasses. It is designed for superior turf quality in full sun to light shade. It will require medium to high management to reach its full potential. Many golf course fairways, home lawns and other turf areas are planted with this mixture where superior turf quality is required. This combination of Kentucky bluegrasses and fine-textured perennial ryegrasses has proven to be a combination that provides improved disease resistance, great color and plant density. This mix will perform at a high level on most soils, from high sands to heavier clay soils where medium to high levels of fertilization and regular irrigation is available. The best results will be achieved with medium to high management levels which will give the turf good color and density. Overseed Mix is an excellent choice for turf areas that are managed by professionals and others who demand high quality turf and are willing to provide the inputs to achieve those goals.

### Recommended Use

Overseed Mix is suited for those turf areas where quality is demanded and management levels support the best possible results. It can be used for nearly any turf area that receives full sun to light shade and receives medium to high levels of management.

### Suggested Maintenance

Best results are achieved with two or more fertilizations per growing season and irrigation that is sufficient to promote healthy growth throughout the growing season. The recommended mowing height is 1.5 - 3 inches although it will perform at slightly lower heights of cut if managed properly.

20% Midnight Kentucky Bluegrass\*

15% Pizzazz Perennial Ryegrass\*

15% Manhattan 5 Perennial Ryegrass\*

### Suggested Seeding Rates (Lower rates take longer fill in; higher rates for quick fill in)

New Seeding – Broadcast – 4 – 6.3 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.; 175 - 275 lbs. per acre

Mechanical – 3.5 – 5.2 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.; 150 - 225 lbs. per acre

Overseeding – Broadcast < 50% Existing desirable plants – same as new seeding

>50% Existing desirable plants–3.2–4.8 lbs.per 1,000 sq.ft;  
140 - 210 lbs. per acre.

Mechanical < 50% Existing desirable plants – same as new seeding

>50% Existing desirable plants –2.6-3.9 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.  
115 - 170 lbs. per acre.
