

KENTUCKY BLUEGRASS

Description:

Right Kentucky bluegrass was developed by Pure-Seed Testing, Inc. Right is a “Midnight” hybrid without the rust pressures, and selected for genetic dark color, low growth habit, and improved shade tolerance. Right also displays tolerance to salt and drought pressure. Right is resistant to leaf spot, stem rust, powdery mildew, leaf rust, and crown rust. With it’s dark green color and high density, Right fits into the category of elite Kentucky bluegrasses which are bred to produce overall turfgrass excellence.

Applications:

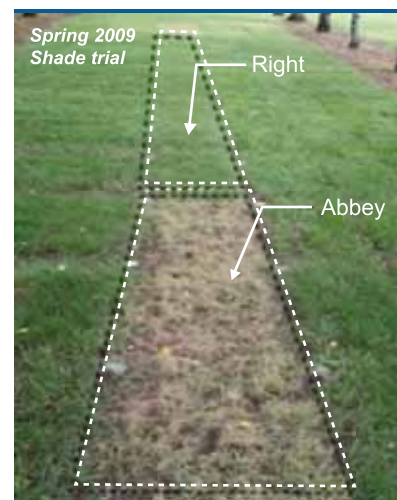
Right is an excellent bluegrass for sod production. It mixes well and compliments perennial ryegrass and tall fescue. Right can handle low mowing .50” (1.25 cm.) and is a popular choice for golf course use. With excellent shade performance characteristics, Right is the perfect choice for stadiums with shade issues or areas of reduced light levels. It is also ideal for low maintenance as it maintains great color with little disease pressure from reduced fertilizer and watering.

Geographical Adaption:

Right performs excellent throughout the typical cool season zones and well into the transition zone. It can be utilized as a component with perennial ryegrass to enhance the seasonal turf performance in the overseeding of Bermuda grass in southern athletic fields.

Right has also performed well in Europe. Seeding rates typically range between 2-3 lbs./1,000 sq. ft (97-146 kg/ha). Normal establishment is between 14-21 days under good growing conditions. Fertilize at 3 lbs N/1000sq.ft./year.
