Boulevard Mixture

Boulevard Mix is designed for situations where salty conditions exist because of winter deicing or high saline soils. These conditions normally vary in native soils and along roadsides. The heaviest salt level is next to the road or sidewalk with progressively decreasing concentrations further from the edge. With this in mind, Boulevard Mix is formulated using grasses that have varying degrees of salt tolerance. This eliminates the need for using multiple products to achieve satisfactory results in these conditions. As salt concentrations increase or decrease, one or more of the components will dominate. The Alkaligrass has the most salt tolerance and will therefore dominate where salt is most prevalent or where salt levels in native soils are the highest. The other grasses used in this mix will adapt to the areas of salt concentration in which they are most adaptable. All grasses used in this mix have been selected because they exhibit good salt tolerance for their species. The texture and color of all grasses used in this mix blend well together assuming a level of salt is present that would make survival of other grasses unlikely.

Recommended Use

Boulevard Mix is designed for areas that have varying levels of salt concentrations. The mix is very specific for sites that exhibit that condition. It will require some level of salt concentration in order to provide satisfactory turf conditions. On soils that do not contain unusual levels of salt, another seed product should be used.

Suggested Maintenance

Best results are achieved with one or two fertilizations per growing season and irrigation as needed to prevent plant dormancy. The recommended mowing height is 2-3 inches with mowing frequency being timed so that no more than approximately 1/3 of the leaf blade is removed with each mowing.

Grasses in Boulevard Mix

25% Bonaire Kentucky Bluegrass*
20% Silver Dollar Perennial Ryegrass*
20% 2nd Millennium Tall Fescue*
15% Saltonsea Alkaligrass*
10% Shadow III Chewings Fescue*
10% Seabreeze GT Creeping Red Fescue*

* Or equivalent depending on availability..

Suggested Seeding Rates

(Lower rates take longer fill in; higher rates for quick fill in)

New Seeding:

Broadcast – 4.3 – 6.3 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.; 185 - 275 lbs. per acre

Mechanical – 3.5 – 5.2 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft.; 150 - 225 lbs. per acre

Overseeding:

Broadcast < 50% Existing desirable plants – same as new seeding

>50% Existing desirable plants – 3.2 – 4.8 lbs. per 1,000 sq.ft; 140 - 210 lbs. per acre.

Mechanical < 50% Existing desirable plants – same as new seeding

>50% Existing desirable plants – 2.6-3.9 lbs. per 1,000 sq. ft. 115 - 170 lbs. per acre.
